Monday, Tuesday, Thursday | 8.30am - 2.30pm

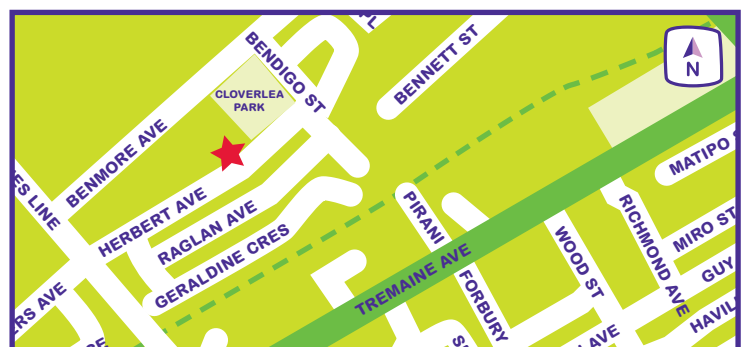
Wednesday and Friday | 8.15am - 12.30pm
